## Overview:

This panel will bring together key stakeholders from hydrogen interest organizations, HDV companies and policy makers from Scandinavia, Germany and the broader Baltic Sea region to discuss the development and implementation of hydrogen infrastructure in Northern Europe.

These topics will be further narrowed down in collaboration with the panelists to ensure a focused and relevant discussion.
