One of the desired outcomes is to raise the awareness with audiences and empower cultural workers to take a leading role in in tackling climate change, as the cultural sector is able to create new narratives, to face the topic in a creative way and to start valuable conversations on sustainability.

Pomerania is one of the greenest areas in Poland. Known for its clean air, cristal lakes, or forest areas, the region is also leading the green revolution in the country. Currently around 50% of the energy produced in Pomerania comes from renewable energy sources, wind being the main resource. With wind offshore to come, and its planned capacity of 11 GW, the region will become 100% green.

The development of the wind offshore will be driven by the Pomeranian Offshore Platform, which currently gathers over 70 representatives of business, ngo's and science, local governments. An important part of the platform is the Centre of Competence and Cooperation that will provide talent the new industry. Very special is that -in this male dominated sector - an inspiring and ambitious woman is leading the Offshore Development here, exposing us towards a strong example of a diverse approach in fostering competitiveness of our region.

In the break out session we will dive into the ambitions of this development centre, the impact on the Offshore sector, the way it is attracting and inspiring a growing number of participants/members and see how this development could be accelerated with the use of the concept of regenerative leadership. This is the kind of leadership that is needed to guide our societies to a transition which is more in accordance with nature. We will dive into much needed competences like cooperation, creativity, awareness and knowledge of natural principles and feminine leadership.







With short introductions about life's principles, regenerative leadership, circular economy, new paradigms as well as the present development around this centre of competence and offshore activities we will inspire the audience and try to "cross-pollinate" in order to share experiences, thoughts etc.
